

## Suggested by team managers Doctrine of competition.

1. Athletes to perform at an appropriate level of competition (allowing for constraints of the competition and technical aspects of events) as determined by discussion between the athletes, coach and team manager.
2. Athletes will not be entered for events for which they have not been coached if Welfare / Safety issues apply.
3. The club will release athletes from club selection to allow for higher level of competition.

### Clash of fixtures:

4. If the clash is with a school event then the school takes precedent.
5. If the clash is between two club events then the athlete, the coach and team manager should attempt to resolve. If it means we can not field a senior team then the needs of the club (The Flagship Team) should come first and the junior team should make alternate arrangements, provided that the athlete is capable of competing safely at senior level. The coach should have already decided this.

N.B. If the Athlete is under 16 years of age reference will also always include parent / legal guardian.
